Dana Hall, M.D. is the Director and Managing Physician of the MD Suite Walk-in Medical Clinic on Carmichael Road, a position he has held since 2014.

Dr. Hall began practicing medicine in The Bahamas in July 2002 as an Intern at the Princess Margaret Hospital where he rotated through the Departments of Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynecology and Pediatrics. He also did three-month rotations in the Departments of Anesthesia (Intensive Care Unit) and Psychiatry. In 2003 he earned the distinction of Medical Intern of the Year after completing his internship.

From 2004 to 2006 Dr. Hall served as Senior House Officer to Drs. Reginald Carey and James Johnson, Consultants in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Princess Margaret Hospital. Dr. Hall also began practicing community-based medicine as an attending physician at the Medi-Center Walk-in Clinic, Prince Charles Drive (2006-2014) and The Walk-in Clinic, Collins Avenue (2008-2012).

After a 2-year rotation at the Sandilands Rehabilitation Center, Dr. Hall returned to the Princess Margaret Hospital in 2008 and resumed the post of Senior House Officer in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology. His responsibilities included management of the maternity and gynecology wards and performing elective and emergency gynecological surgeries. He was also the second on call for all admissions to the hospital with respect to any obstetric and gynecologic patients and attended to patients at the antenatal/gynecological community outpatient clinics.

Dr. Hall obtained his Bachelor of Science Degree in Zoology with a Minor in Chemistry from Howard University (1992) and completed a Post Baccalaureate Programme in Biology at the University of Miami (1993). His Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery Degrees were obtained at the University of the West Indies, Kingston, Jamaica (2002).

Dr. Hall is licensed by the Bahamas Medical Council and the General Medical Council with full registration since July 2002 to the present.
