La Verne Burrows-Deleveaux's career in Banking has spanned 35 years with extensive experience in Private Banking and Trusts. She entered the industry in 1982 as a Senior Clerk in the Banking Department of Coutts Bahamas Ltd. and worked her way up the ladder to the positions of Senior Securities Clerk, Securities Department; Securities Administrator, Client Trading Department and finally Assistant Manager, Securities Department, SG Hambros Bank and Trust (Bahamas) Limited after the bank underwent several changes in ownership and name.

As Assistant Manager, Securities she was responsible for securities issues such as the settlements of stocks and bonds trading; corporate actions processes including rights issues, dividend payables, mergers and acquisitions, spin-offs and return of capital. In this role she frequently liaised with Client Relationship Managers, Investment Managers and external advisors and brokers on corporate actions and settlement issues. Her work also included assisting with staff training and development, reviewing systems, implementing processes and identifying areas for improvement, along with investigations of transactions, analysis and interpretation of management and financial data.

In 2002 Mrs. Burrows-Deleveaux joined The Bank of Nova Scotia Trust Company (Bahamas) Ltd., where she worked for the next fifteen years. While serving as Senior Operations Officer, Securities Mrs. Deleveaux was responsible for assisting the manager with staff supervision and facilitating the achievement of the staff's personal and team objectives. She oversaw settlement of securities trading and corporate actions processes including stock splits, mergers and acquisitions, spin-offs and dividend payables; supervised the settlements of stocks and bonds trading and investigated transactions and resolve issues. She was relied upon to analyze and interpret management and financial data and oversee depository reconciliations while providing custodial vault duties and liaising with Trust Administrators, Investment Managers and external advisors and brokers on corporate actions and settlement issues. Mrs. Burrows-Deleveaux also provided training, coaching and counseling to members of the department and she, herself, received short term training in The ARTS Team (a review of Trust Companies and businesses to ensure that they are compliant to policies and laws.)

Mrs. Burrows-Deleveaux is a graduate of St Anne's High School. She received her Banker's Associates (ABIB) from The Bahamas Institute of Bankers in 1989 and an Associate Degree in Banking from The College of The Bahamas (1993).
